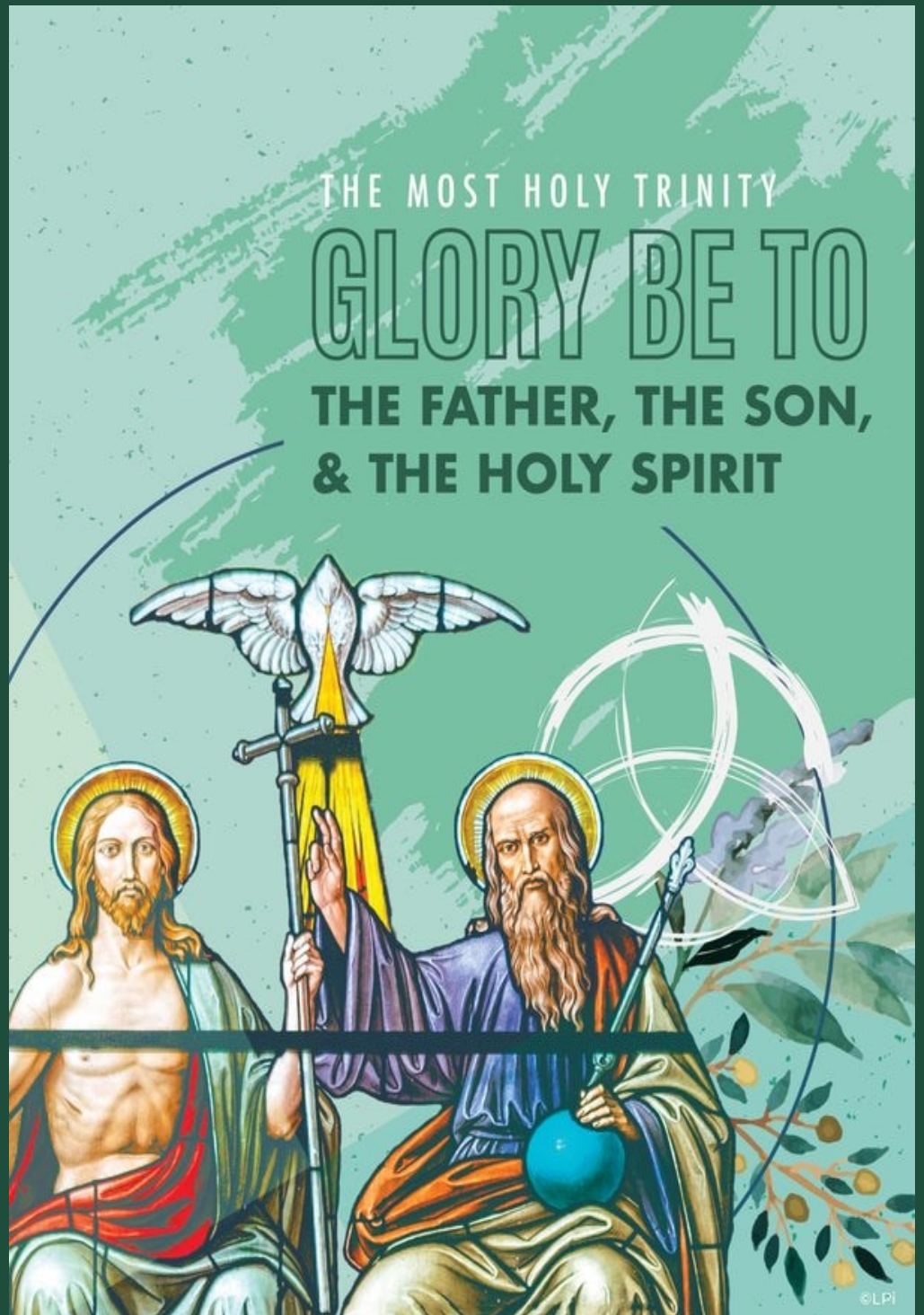

### JUNE — THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, a devotion that reminds us of the deep and personal love Jesus has for each one of us. The image of the Sacred Heart symbolizes Christ's compassion, mercy, sacrifice, and unfailing love for humanity. His heart burns with love for all people and calls us to respond with faith, trust, and love in return.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart became especially popular through the revelations received by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. Jesus revealed His Sacred Heart as a source of mercy and grace and invited the faithful to draw closer to Him through prayer, repentance, and devotion. Through this devotion, we are reminded that God is never distant from our struggles, fears, or sufferings. Instead, Christ walks with us and offers comfort, healing,



and peace.

During the month of June, Catholics throughout the world honor the Sacred Heart in a special way through prayer, Eucharistic adoration, Holy Hours, and the praying of the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Families are also encouraged to enthrone the Sacred Heart in their homes as a visible reminder that Christ is the center of family life.

In a world often marked by division, anxiety, and uncertainty, devotion to the Sacred Heart invites us to rediscover the power of God's love and mercy. Jesus tells us in the Gospel: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). His Sacred Heart remains open to all who seek Him.

May this month of June be an opportunity for all of us to grow closer to Christ, to deepen our prayer life, and to place our trust in His loving Heart. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us.

The skilled staff help find solutions to the challenges expectant mothers are facing, so they can focus on preparing to parent their child in a safe, stable home or consider the loving choice of adoption.

## FAREWELL AND THANK YOU TO MISSIONARY SISTERS OF CHRIST THE KING

The Missionary Sisters of Christ the King for Polonia founded in Poland in 1959 by Fr. Ignacy Posadzy, a priest of the Society of Christ. The congregation was created specifically to serve Polish emigrants living outside of Poland.

Their motto is often expressed as:  
**“Everything for God and for the Polish Emigrants”**

Church leaders believed these emigrants needed spiritual and cultural support so they would not become isolated from their faith and heritage.

Today the congregation serves in many countries around the world while remaining focused on ministry to the Polish diaspora (“Polonia”)

St. Ferdinand in 1995 was rapidly growing with influx of the Polish emigrants, so it was an easy decision to welcome and embrace the sisters.

### **Their work included:**

Teaching catechism, language, culture and traditions

Helping Polish Parishes such as sacristan work

Assist in schools, parish offices, and many other corporal works of mercy

So, as the era comes to an end, with heartfelt gratitude, we thank Sister Agnieszka Michna and Sister Bogusia Bladek of the Missionary Sisters of Christ the King, for their faithful service to the Polish community at St. Ferdinand Church currently and all of the Missionary Sisters of Christ the King who came before them over the last 30 years.

Sr. Agnieszka devoted herself to teaching religion and preparing generations of children for their First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Gifted with musical talent, she lovingly guided the angelic voices of “Kropeczki” a children’s choir, and faithfully led “Ziarenko” every Sunday, enriching our children’s knowledge of the Bible, prayer, songs and spiritual joy.

Sr. Bogusia blessed with artistic gifts, served faithfully as a sacristan. Through her beautiful paintings, creativity, floral arrangements and a loving care of the sanctuary for every celebration, she helped to create the sacred space where Jesus was truly welcomed and honored.

Their dedication, kindness, faith and countless sacrifices have touched the lives of so many families and strengthened our parish community in immeasurable ways.

As they move onto another parish to continue fulfilling their mission, we extend our prayers, best wishes and sincere thanks for the years of service to St. Ferdinand Parish and the Polish community. May God continue to guide and bless them as they begin this new chapter of service. Though they will be greatly missed, their legacy of faith, love and devotion will remain in our hearts forever.

Najświętszemu Sercu Pana Jezusa za grzechy nasze i całego świata. Wśród obietnic Najświętszego Serca Jezusowego jest łaska wytrwania w wierze oraz pomoc w godzinie śmierci.

Aby odprawić Dziewięć Pierwszych Piątków Miesiąca

zgodnie z praktyką Kościoła i obietnicą przekazaną św. Małgorzacie Marii Alacoque, należy:

- **Przez dziewięć kolejnych miesięcy zachować pierwszy piątek miesiąca bez przerwy.** Jeśli jeden opuścisz, trzeba zacząć od początku.
- **Przystąpić do spowiedzi świętej** – niekoniecznie dokładnie w pierwszy piątek, ale tak, by być w stanie łaski uświęcającej w dniu przyjęcia Komunii Świętej. Wiele osób spowiada się kilka dni wcześniej lub w sam pierwszy piątek.
- **Przyjąć Komunię Świętą w pierwszy piątek miesiąca** jako wynagrodzenie Najświętszemu Sercu Pana Jezusa.
- **Mieć intencję wynagradzającą** – ofiarować tę Komunię Świętą jako wynagrodzenie za grzechy swoje i całego świata, szczególnie za zniewagi wobec Najświętszego Serca Jezusowego.

Dobrze jest także w tym dniu uczestniczyć we Mszy Świętej, odmówić Litanii do Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa albo poświęcić chwilę na adorację. To nabożeństwo nie jest „magiczną obietnicą”, ale drogą do głębszej miłości do Jezusa, regularnej spowiedzi i życia sakramentalnego.

Różaniec to modlitwa, która może zmienić człowieka, rodzinę, społeczeństwo, a nawet narody.
