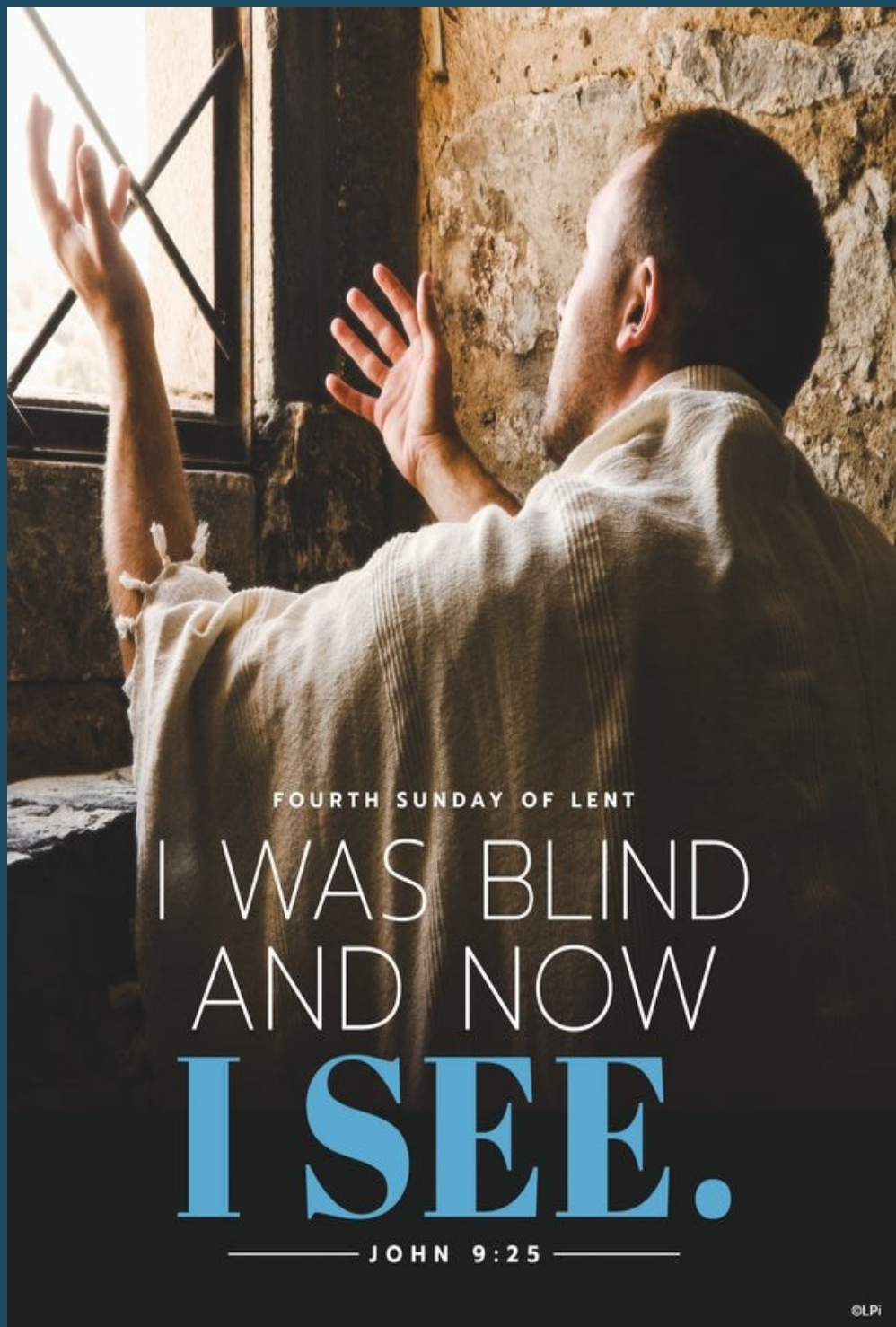

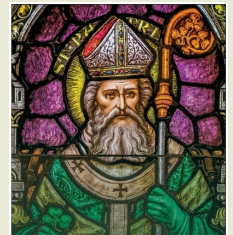

MARCH 17 ST. PATRICK'S DAY



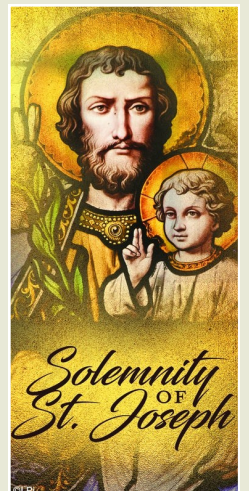

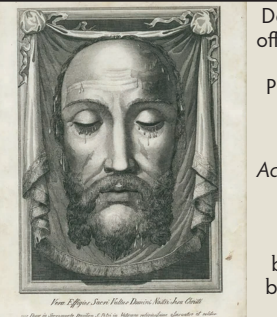
