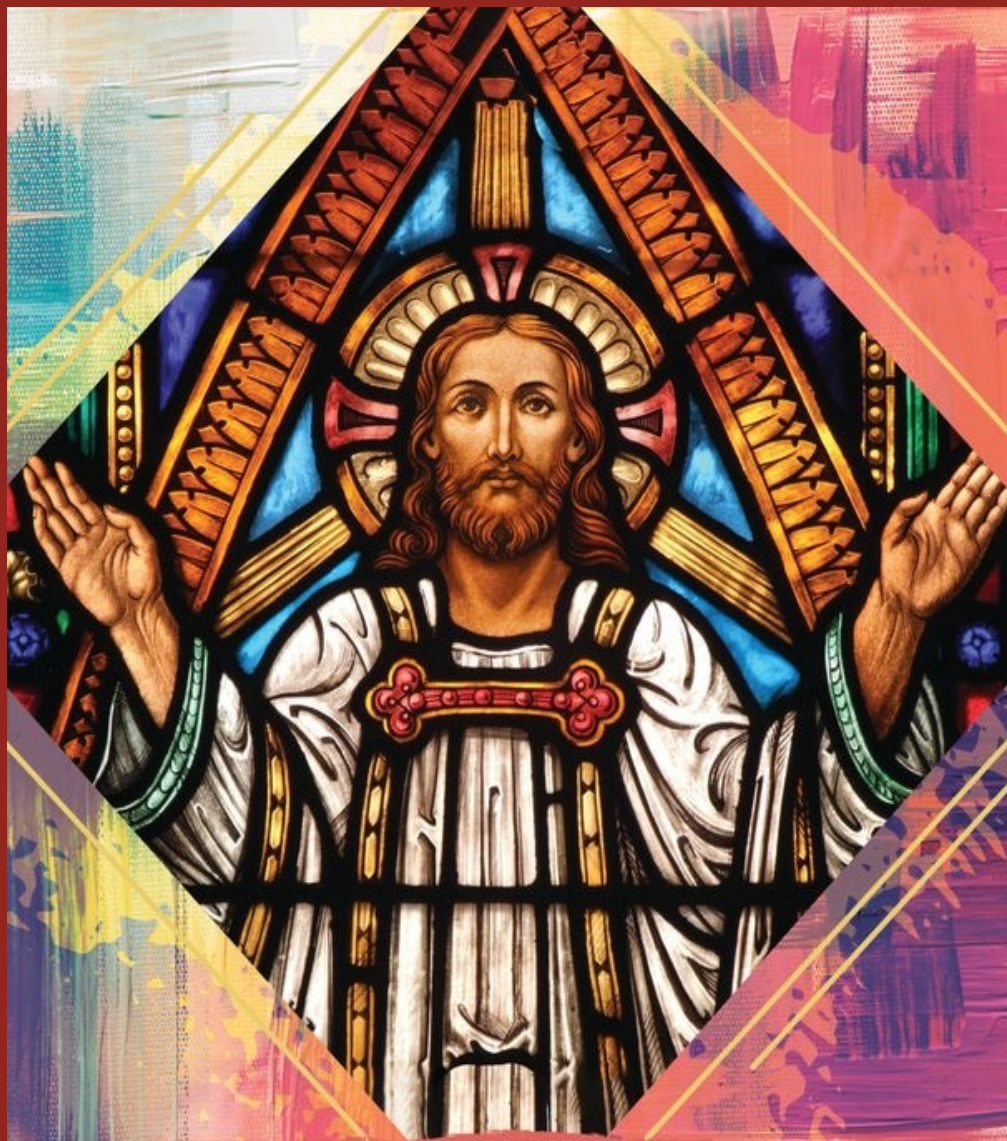

ACTION ALERT

Please contact Governor Pritzker to VETO SB 1950 - Legalizing Assisted Suicide

At 2:54 a.m. on October 31 the Illinois State Senate narrowly passed SB 1950. The State House narrowly passed the bill in the Spring. The bill is now on the Governor's desk. This is the last chance to stop assisted suicide from becoming law in Illinois.

In Canada where assisted suicide has been legal since 2016, 1 in 20 deaths are now due to assisted suicide/euthanasia. Too many are giving up on life under this law.

PLEASE CALL GOV. PRITZKER AND INFORM HIM:

- **People with disabilities, the poor and marginalized fear coercion and abuse under assisted suicide laws.**
- **Suicide rates increase in states where assisted suicide is legal, especially among veterans.**
- **There is a possible cost savings to insurance companies as they can provide cheaper lethal drugs instead of lifesaving treatments.**

With a heavy heart we need to say Goodbye to our Associate Pastor: Fr. Stan, who has to return to Poland on November 30 this year due to serious health issues. It was Father's choice to return to Poland where he already has a history with that health issue treatment.

We are very grateful for his faithful ministry at our Parish in 3 languages: English, Polish and Spanish. Everyone will miss his commitment to the Sacrament of Penance (Confessions) where he spent a huge amount of time every day, especially on Sundays in his Confession Room. His musical talents will be greatly missed by all, especially his beautiful organ music for Funerals and other Masses, and his accordion music for our Volunteer Christmas Party and SummerFest.

Get well Fr Stan, we will pray and wait for your return one day, God's willing. For everything: Thank you and God bless you.

With that unexpected change in our Ministry Staff situation, I will be the only priest St. Ferdinand parish for most of the week masses from Monday to Friday. On Saturdays and Sundays, Fr Marek Duran, our weekend helper from the Mundelein Seminary will help me with his ministry in 3 languages: English, Polish and Spanish.

We don't know yet if we will have another fulltime Associate Pastor here due to a severe shortage of Priests these days. I am already making some arrangements with the local parishes for any extra emergency help for those days when I have a Funeral and I am unable to celebrate the 12:00pm noon Mass or sent a Deacon for the Wake or Cemetery Services.

Please, keep praying for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life and Permanent Diaconate.
