FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Good Friday is obligatory day of universal fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

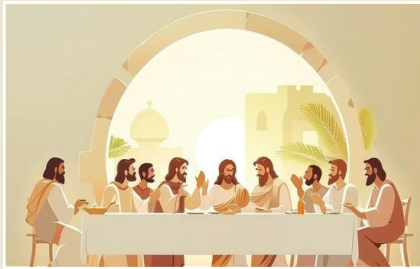
POST ŚCISŁY

Przypominamy, że w Wielki Piątek obowiązuje nas post ścisły. Post ścisły polega na ograniczeniu się w ciągu dnia wyłącznie do jednego posiłku do syta oraz dwóch niepełnych. Przestrzegać powinni go wszyscy katolicy od 18. roku życia do rozpoczęcia 60. roku życia. Dodatkowo post ścisły w Wielki Piątek oznacza, że wszyscy powyżej 14. roku życia mają w te dni powstrzymać się od spożycia mięsa. Przepis ten obowiązuje każdego katolika do końca życia.

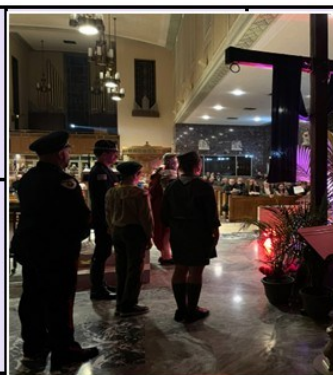

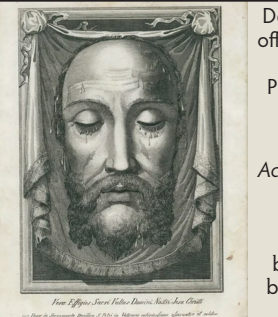
